**Call to order** - At approximately 5:00 pm on August 8, 2018, Mr. Kistner, Chairman of the Beer Board for the Beer Board for the City of Bristol, Tennessee, called the meeting to order in the conference room of the Ewell L. Easley Municipal Bldg., located at 104 Eighth St., Bristol Tennessee.

**Review of Minutes** - Board members reviewed minutes from the July 18, 2018 meeting and the minutes were approved as read.

**NEW BUSINESS**

**The Pinnacle, 529 Pinnacle Parkway, Bristol, TN:** Heather Hill appeared before the board to request a temporary permit renewal due to a change of address. Lt. Brown advised the board that fees were paid and all paperwork was in order. Chairman Kistner called for questions. With no questions presented, Mr. Ketron made a motion to approve. Mr. Walden seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously by the board.

**Last Lap (Rogers Gardens), 2800 Hwy 11E, Bristol, TN:** Mr. Rogers, the owner, appeared before the board to request a temporary permit renewal. Lt. Brown advised the board that the fees have been paid. Mr. Kistner called for questions. With no questions presented, Mr. Ketron made a motion to approve. Mr. Walden seconded the motion and it was approved unanimously by the board.

**PENDING BUSINESS**

**M&M Market, 879 Hwy 126, Bristol, TN:** Christopher Miller, the owner, appeared before the board on July 18, 2018 to request an off premises permit. At that time, the application was held pending to allow for additional investigation due to previous adverse factors. Lt. Tate advised the board that no violations were found upon a follow up investigation that took place on August 2<sup>nd</sup>. He confirmed that no beer was found inside the cooler for sale and that the employee who sold the alcohol on the previous investigation was no longer at the business. Christopher Miller appeared before the board for approval of the permit. Mr. Kistner called for questions. With no questions presented, Mr. Ketron made a motion to approve. Mr. Walden seconded the motion and it was unanimously approved.
