City offers bonuses to Firefighter and Paramedic applicants with previous certifications

The City of Bristol Tennessee is always looking for reliable people with a good work ethic, great attitude, lots of energy, and a passion for helping others. “If this sounds like something you may be interested in, the City is now accepting applications for entry-level positions of Firefighter and Tennessee Certified Paramedics,” stated Mary Lee Williams, Director of the Department of Administration. “The City is making every effort to ensure that those living in the area have the opportunity to be a part of what we all know is a special group of dedicated individuals.”

Any Paramedic with the Tennessee Certification may be eligible to receive a bonus incentive up to \$2,000. Firefighters who have attended Basic Firefighting Academy and obtained Firefighter II Certification may also be eligible to receive a bonus incentive up to \$2,000 in accordance with City policy. Applicants who have both these certifications could receive a total incentive package of up to \$4,000.

An Open House is being offered from 2 PM to 6 PM on Friday, November 9, 2018 at Fire Station 5 located at 1404 Highway 11-W, Bristol, Tennessee 37620. The Open House will allow persons not familiar with what it is like to be a firefighter to talk with a firefighter in the station setting.

Anyone interested in being a part of the Bristol Tennessee Fire Department must first complete an application on-line at <https://www.bristoltn.org/jobs.aspx> in order to take a Fire Entrance Exam which is scheduled for Friday, December 7, 2018. The deadline to apply online is Sunday, November 11, 2018. Once an application has been completed more information on the testing site and time will be provided. Applications received after the deadline will be held until the next testing.
